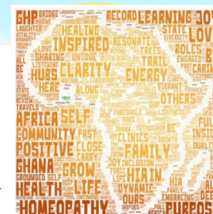

GHANA HOMEOPATHY PROJECT

SUPPORTING CLINICAL SKILLS OF HOMEOPATHS IN GHANA

We have been busy over the last few months developing our plans in the upcoming year for the project to consolidate all the work done in the last few years. The focus of our work has been on supporting the graduates of our professional programme and facilitating their transition into practice. Ghana is suffering from serious economic challenges right now with a high inflation rate, creating obstacles for many people in making ends meet and that impacts all walks of life, including making a living as a homeopath!

Therefore we felt the need to mainly work with the existing graduates of the four year programme to support their ongoing need for more clinical education and practice building skills. Also the Board of Trustees has been busy in developing the necessary procedures, documents and team building measures to further our work in Ghana.

Since traveling to Ghana right now is quite restricted, we have been working hard to develop a team of mentors/supervisors from the UK and elsewhere, so we can support the graduates as much as possible from the UK. Also, given that the project has been active for over 15 years and has been supporting many clinics and practitioners in Ghana, there is now a strong base of committed homeopaths in the country, working in various clinics or running their own practices. Therefore, ensuring that these practitioners are able to work and make a living has been the focus of our work. This is being achieved in the following ways:

- ◇ Ensuring that all practitioners who have graduated from our professional 4 year programme are registered and certified in Ghana through the Traditional Medical Practitioners Council. The four-year programme has been accredited through the Society of Homeopaths in the UK.
- ◇ Supporting existing clinics with necessary homeopathic supplies.
- ◇ Supporting the development of a new clinic in Kumasi City.
- ◇ Sending complete homeopathic medicine kits to Ghana to supply all the graduates and clinics with a full homeopathic kit for professional practice.
- ◇ Developing a Mentorship/Supervisory team in the UK.
- ◇ Offering an 8 month Continuing Professional Development (CPD) programme for all graduates.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

We have created a programme where each graduate is able to consult with their mentors (all of whom we are in great debt to for their commitment to support the graduates) and review either their own cases or cases by others in a formal way in order to give some more clinical education experience and to evaluate the strengths and challenges people are having in looking at issues of case analysis skills, Materia Medica knowledge, Repertory knowledge and case management. Each graduate is given either one long or four shorter cases to do in one month and this is reviewed with the mentor before being sent to the evaluation committee for final review. Over an eight month period, eight cases (or more smaller ones) will be reviewed, analysed, written up and then assessed, with the mentor being available to support this process. We have recently commenced the whole process and will be reviewing how it is working over the next months. From the experience gleaned during this process, it can inform us how we then develop further teaching goals and the type of material that should be offered to enhance their practice skills.

HOMEOPATHIC SUPPLIES/REMEDIES:

We were very fortunate in being donated an amazing supply of homeopathic remedies, many from **Helios Pharmacy**, by two homeopaths from Devon. This included a number of medicated potencies that can be used as a stock source of remedies in various clinics that we are supporting. All the graduates will be given bottles and sac lac and will be able to make up their own kits to have for their own practice and clinics. As can be imagined, this is quite a task to coordinate but we have been fortunate in being able to have access to these remedies, so thanks to all the people donating remedies and to **Helios Pharmacy**.

FUNDRAISING CHALLENGES & GRATITUDE:

We are always looking for continued support as we plan our programme now for the next year. We have been fortunate to receive ongoing support from **Charles Wansborough**, who has been a long term supporter of the project. Also, we have appreciated the support of **The Tanner Trust** over the years. We run on a small budget but we are looking now how to support our work in an ongoing way, including having people working for us in Ghana.
